This home is priced at \$288,900. This includes lot prep, impact fees, well, septic, paved driveway, 24-by-24-inch porcelain tile throughout, 12-by-24-inch decorator porcelain shower tile and many more upscale features. The Marquesa is priced at \$92 per total square foot.
